



ORDER NO. 012224-01

AN ORDER OF THE MUSTANG SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 4, 2024 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AT LARGE; AND PROVIDING DETAILS RELATING TO THE HOLDING OF SUCH ELECTION. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUSTANG SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

Section 1. In accordance with the general laws and Constitution of the State of Texas, a General Election is hereby called and ordered for the first Saturday in **May 2024**, the same being the **4th** day of said month, at which election all qualified voters of the District may vote for the purpose of electing three Board of Directors at large.

Section 2. No person's name shall be placed upon the official ballot as a candidate for any of the above-mentioned offices unless such person shall have filed his or her sworn application, as provided by Section 141.031 of the Texas Election Code, with the Board Secretary of Mustang Special Utility District, at the District offices, 7985 FM 2931, Aubrey, Texas, on or before 4:30 o'clock (4:30) p.m. on the 78th day before the election (February 16, 2024).

Section 3. The order in which the names of the candidates are to be printed on the ballot shall be determined by a drawing by the Board Secretary as provided by Section 52 of the Texas Election Code.

Section 4. The District polling place shall be Mustang SUD Offices, 7985 FM 2931, Aubrey, Texas 76227 and Gunter First Baptist Church-Foyer, 99 Gentle Creek Ln., Gunter Texas 75058. The polls shall, on said Election Day, be open from seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. to seven o'clock (7:00) p.m.

Section 5. The Election Administration will appoint at a later date the Presiding Judge and Alternate Presiding Judge. The Presiding Judge will then appoint the clerks of the election in a number not to exceed three clerks.

Section 6. In accordance with Sec. 51 of the Election Code, the Election Administrator is hereby authorized and instructed to secure and furnish all necessary election supplies to conduct said election. Any voter of the District may request the use of a voting station that meets the accessibility requirements for voting by a person with a disability. Requests must be received no later than the 45th day before election.

Section 7. The Election Administration is hereby appointed clerk for early voting. The early voting for the above-designated election shall be at Mustang S.U.D. Offices, 7985 FM 2931, Aubrey, Texas 76227 and Gunter First Baptist Church-Foyer, 99 Gentle Creek Ln. Gunter, Texas 75058.

Said place of early voting shall remain open for at least eight (8) hours on each day for early voting which is not a Saturday or Sunday, or an official state or federal holiday, beginning on the 12th day, and continuing through the 4th day preceding the date of said election (**April 22, 2024 through April 30, 2024**). Section 85.001(e) for an election held on the uniform election date in May, the period for early voting by personal appearance begins on the 12th day before Election Day and

continues through the 4th day before Election Day. Said places of voting shall remain open from eight o'clock (8:00) a.m. to five o'clock (5:00) p.m. on each day for said early voting.

Section 8. Early voting, both by personal appearance and by mail shall be canvassed by an Early Voting Ballot Board.

Section 9. Said election shall be held in accordance with the Texas Election Code. All qualified voters of the District shall be eligible to vote at said election for the purpose of electing three Board of Directors at large.

Section 10. The Election Administration shall give notice of this election in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Texas Election Code, and all necessary orders and writs for said election shall be issued by the proper authority.

ADOPTED, this 22th day of January 2024 at a regularly scheduled meeting, with a quorum present, of the Mustang Special Utility District Board of Directors.
